Attended by more than 4,000 patrons, the Lakewood Home Festival has raised approximately \$1 million for local schools since 1976. Last year's home festival raised approximately \$146,000 for the three schools.

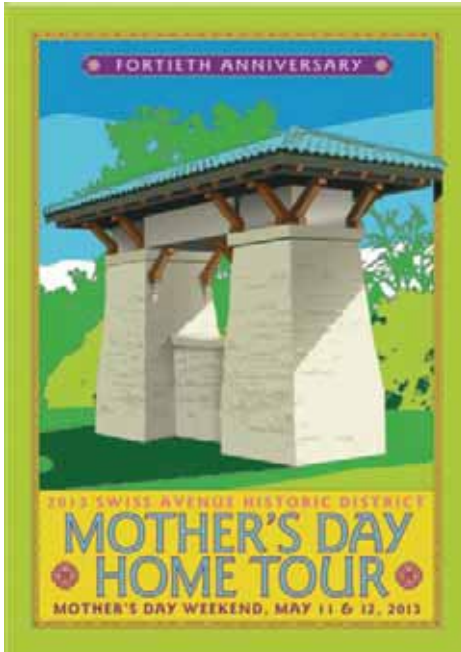

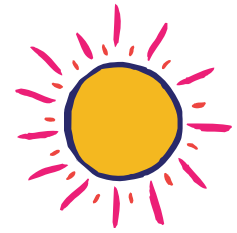

### The Best Bubbles Ever

6 cups water  
2 cups Dawn dishwashing liquid  
3/4 cup light corn syrup

Mix all ingredients together in a LARGE container of sorts...an empty water bottle, milk jug, etc. Shake everything up and let sit for a few hours. Pour into empty bubbles containers or dishes and go wild with your bubble wands!!

### Homemade Playdough

1 cup flour  
1 cup warm water  
2 tsp. cream of tartar  
1 tsp. oil  
1/4 cup salt  
food coloring

1. Mix all ingredients together. Stir with a wooden spoon over medium heat until the dough thickens, pulls away from the sides, and forms a ball (about 5-10 minutes).
2. Remove from pan and knead until blended smooth.
3. Add Food coloring a few drops at a time and knead until the color is incorporated.
4. Store in a plastic bag or airtight container when cooled.

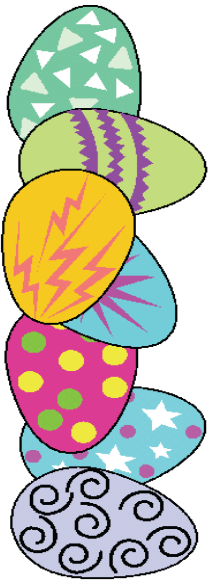
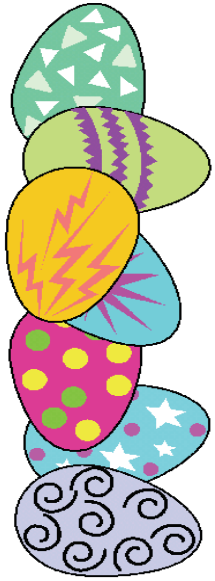
